Results of the project

Partners have finalised the work on the first two results of the project: the LCV Competence map and the collection of mobile technologies for training of LCV drivers.

The Competence Map collects common European competences and knowledge which a Light Commercial Vehicle driver should acquire for his/her profession.

The LCV Competence Map was created through administering online questionnaires to drivers and trainers, in order to understand which were the most important competences for companies and to collect further information on online training.

Furthermore, Output 2 has been completed. It is a collection of mobile technologies for learning. Apps, softwares and programmes which could be useful for drivers have been shared on a Google+ community (you can visit it on this link https://plus.google.com/u/0/communities/108065324565791322448) the partners have collected tools that trainers can use and suggest during the training and that can support drivers' working activities. For example there is an app which supports drivers in first aid, or an app which constantly checks fuel prices etc.


Partners are now working on Output 3, that is the training path for e-learning use. A 32-hour training course will be created, and web-based learning materials will be provided, including collected tools in O2.

First Project Meeting








Second Project Meeting
